

# Welcome to Copper Harbor

We hope your layover in Copper Harbor will be a pleasant one. Please do not hesitate to ask if you are in need of anything to make your stay more enjoyable. The maps included in your packet will help you identify points of special interest to you.



Some items of note for your stay in Copper Harbor:

- **Musher Parking** Volunteers will be present to assist you in parking your vehicle. Your cooperation with them is appreciated. There has been some concern with congestion on the side streets on Saturday evening when mushers decide to move around for one reason or another. It has been suggested that if you need to move, and are looking for a quieter location, that Wall St up to First Street and down First Street to Second Street are good spots. Obviously look to see if there is room before you drive over there.
- The **Vet Station** is shown in the location on the attached map.
- The **Leaderboard** will be located inside the Community Building.
- **Restrooms** are located in the Community Center. They can be entered from the rear of the building. Porta-Johns will also be available. Everyone is using these, please be mindful and courteous.
- **Hot water** is available in the Community Center..
- On Saturday, **refreshments will be available** at the Community Building.
- **Free Sled Dog Rides**, sponsored by CHIA (Copper Harbor Improvement Association), for children will be available in the park adjacent to the Grant Township Hall on Saturday from 3PM to 4:30PM on Saturday.
- **Awards for the CopperDog 15 and 80** will be in the Mariner North Dining Room at 4:30PM
- **Dinner** - Mariner North will be serving dinner until 10PM on Saturday night. We are beyond thankful to them for going above and beyond for race weekend. As the one and only food stop in Copper Harbor we thank them for their extended hours and hard work. Please be mindful as you visit them that it will be busy there with such an influx of people for 48 hours. Please remember to thank the staff as well as owners Donny and Peg who have sponsored the Copper Harbor Checkpoint for 2023 and work behind the scenes helping with CopperDog.
- **The Gas Light General Store 'The Genny'** is open from **10am-8pm on Saturday** and **8am-7pm on Sunday** and they are offering free coffee for the volunteers and mushers! While you're there make sure to check the daily soup option as Staci makes some of the best soups around and you can buy by the bowl. Also, if you need it, they probably have it. Amazing fresh veg and fruit, delicious cheeses, beer, wine, pop, juice, medicine...you get the picture.
